RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE COUNTY'S 9-1-1 FEE

Recitals


- A. Md. Code, Public Safety § 1-311 allows the County Commissioners to impose a County 9-1-1 fee.
- B. Currently the fee is \$0.75 for each switched local exchange access service, CMRS, or other 9-1-1 accessible service.
- C. The County Commissioners may increase the fee if revenues to cover the County's 9-1-1 system operational costs are not met.
- D. Because the costs are not being met by revenues, the County Commissioners wish to increase the fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland that the County's 9-1-1 fee for each switched local exchange access service, CMRS, or other 9-1-1 accessible service is raised to \$1.50.


